

# Message from the Acting High Commissioner Or. Satyanjal Pandey

This is the pathway to Viksit Bharat. On this path, we seek to be a partner in progress for our neighbours and the global community. Our mantra of Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas is reflected in our Neighbourhood First Policy and SAGAR Vision.

Sri Lanka is a key partner under the rubric. India and Sri Lanka not only are fellow democracies, sharing in our diversity and dynamism, we are civilisational partners, sharing our history, language, religion and ethos. Our stories have intertwined — and our futures are interlinked. Our geographical proximity makes us natural partners and the same proximity demands a mutual sensitivity to each other's interests. It also requires each of us to support the other with an unmatched spontaneity, unencumbered by third party pulls and pressures.

India has time and again demonstrated that it is a dependable partner and a reliable friend for Sri Lanka. 
